

From Francis: SOME OBSERVATIONS ON RESTING IN THE SPIRIT

One of the many recent blessings is that I have signed a contract with Chosen Books to write a short book on "resting in the Spirit" (but it has to be finished by April 20!). Over the past 20 years I have noticed many things about "resting" that I am eager to share. Following are a few of these reflections on how long it lasts and how often it occurs.

Resting in the Spirit seems to occur in our ministry (we carit speak for others) just about every time we pray in a healing service for ten or more people when they are standing. It's not something we do; we trust that it's something God is doing (although several recent books, like Cardinal Suenens' Resting in the Spirit question whether or not much of it is a merely psychological phenomenon).

One fascinating thing is that it varies in frequency. Several months ago I prayed for several hundred people and only about one in ten rested.

At other times almost nine out of ten rest. What does this mean? It might mean that the first group was resistant; or, it could be that, because they were unfamiliar with the phenomenon, the Lord was protecting us from unnecessary criticism; or, on the other hand, it could be that the group was more spiritually mature (as people grow more accustomed to the power of the Spirit, their bodies react less) - or, then again, it may be that I needed to be more spiritually prepared for the healing service. One thing: we are tempted to judge others - and the Lord tells us not to! The best thing we can do is to go on about our praying without trying to judge, except insofar as it will help us minister better. If we suspect for instance, that we haven't prepared ourselves sufficiently ("this kind can only be driven out by prayer and fasting"-Jesus), then we need to prepare better the next time.

How long does this state of resting last? Several times I have seen it last for about 6 hours. At the other end of the spectrum are those who fall, without much really happening inside them. For most people at our services the resting takes at least a few minutes, and occasionally (one out of a hundred) someone rests half an hour or more. When a person does rest for a longer period of time it usually means that something deep is going on inside of them

Francis & Judith MacNutt




Francis was one of the first Catholic priests to become involved in the Charismatic Renewal and is known around the world for his dynamic preaching and healing ministry. He is the author of the best-

sellers *Healing, The Power to Heal, and The Prayer That Heals*. His books have been translated into two dozen languages. An honors graduate from Harvard, Francis earned his Ph. D. from Aquinas Institute of Theology.

Judith MacNutt, a psychotherapist, received her Master's in psychology from Eastern Kentucky University. She founded a house of prayer in Israel where she witnessed many miracles---inner healings, deliverances and physical healings. It was also here where she met Francis. Later, she began Christian Counseling Service in Clearwater, Fl. Judith and Francis co-authored *Praying for Your Unborn Child* and are the parents of two children, Rachel and David.

REV. DON WILLIAMS



Don Williams, pastor of The Vineyard Christian Fellowship of The Coast in San Diego, is the host for this conference. He's been described as a "solid evangelical pastor who was trained to believe in the power

of human reason and the reliability of the scientific method". But that was before God shattered that perception through the power of signs and wonders.

A graduate of Princeton University and Princeton Theological Seminary, Don has a Ph.D from Columbia University and has written a series of critically acclaimed commentaries on the Psalms. He's also authored Journey Into Joy and The Apostle Paul and Women in the Church. His most recent work is Signs, Wonders and the Kingdom of God--A Biblical Guide for the Reluctant Skeptic.

FR. JACK McGINNIS



Fr. Jack McGinnis is a priest of the Diocese of Galveston, Texas. A creative musician and a recovering alcoholic, he works on a full-time ministry to alcoholics, adult children of alcoholics, and members of

dysfunctional families. Since 1986 he has been conducting "Freedom Weekends," 3-day spiritual workshops dealing with the pain, fears, anxieties and other emotional dysfunctions caused by childhood experiences. Fr. Jack's experience with alcohol dates back to his childhood. He began drinking at 13 and continued until he entered the seminary. He resumed drinking after he was ordained in 1963. He began abusing prescription drugs in 1965 and also used marijuana until 1970, when God spoke to him on two occasions. Since 1980, he has worked full-time in the healing and evangelism ministries with the affirmation of his Bishop.

BARBARA LEAHY SHLEMON



Barbara Leahy Shlemon, a Roman Catholic laywoman, has been involved in the healing ministry for the last quarter century. A registered nurse, Barbara was instrumental in establishing the Association of

Christian Therapists in 1975. This organization is composed of professionals in the health and mental health care fields who seek to integrate faith experience with their medical training.

Barbara helped found houses of prayer in Libertyville, IL and Clearwater, FL which continue to be centers for healing resources for those seeking wellness. In 1988, she established Be-Loved Ministry in Torrance, CA.

Barbara has written Healing Prayer, Healing the Hidden Self, Living Each Day by the Power of Faith and To Heal as Jesus Healed.




THOMAS WIKSTROM, M.D.


He works in a St. Augustine Clinic and to start will spend one day per week at CHM.


We welcome Dr. Wikstrom, his wife Jan and lovely daughter Elizabeth to Jacksonville and CHM.
