On April 22 I reach my 70th birthday

In so many ways I feel as if I am just **beginning**. I am still learning, and not just in small things, but in the great ideals: who I want to be as a human being and as a Christian. In this brief essay I want to share with you a little of what I have learned as an encouragement for all of us to continue to grow and to hope.

In the last newsletter I wrote briefly about how the Church's answer in one century can become a barrier to growth for the next generation. Closer to home, I have found the same problem in my own life: what was my total ambition at one period of my life was only a partial solution. To the extent that I believed it was the complete answer, it became a problem - but, at the time, I didn't realize it!

Just to give one example, when I was younger I was very absolute about my ideals and this idealism was closely connected with keeping the law. I tended to be legalistic and judgmental when other people didn't seem to keep the law, but I saw my absolut-

ism as a desire to be virtuous. I saw myself as a person who held myself and others to high standards. Because I read the Gospels (part of my high standard) I realized the danger of being like the Pharisees. I didn't want to be a Pharisee, and yet, in some ways, I was. I was harsh, not so much in what I said, but in what I thought about people. I was very critical and people sensed it. It made for loneliness. I was admirable, but not very lovable.

It is good to hold to high standards, but the way I did it made it hard for me to love people and even harder I'm sure for them to love me. I thank God for the people he has brought into my life to help change that: for Judith and our children, and before that for all the people I worked with in St. Louis, and in my many travels.

I also thank God for bringing me into the healing ministry some thirty years ago, for it is here that I have seen how many people are not free to act upon what they know is right deep within. They experience what Paul was describing in Romans 7:15 where he said that he did the very things he hated and failed to live up to the ideals he embraced in his heart of hearts. In truth, we need Jesus, a Savior who can rescue us from ourselves.

The healing ministry can hardly fail to make us more compassionate when we realize that people are not totally free. There is a degree of freedom, yes, but there are areas where sin blinds our vision and drives our will, where we (as sinners, I John 1:8) desperately need prayer for healing and sometimes deliverance. I simply cannot judge a person's inner motives. I have always known that I shouldn't judge, but now I really know that I can't judge.

It has also helped me to see how mistaken I have often been in my own

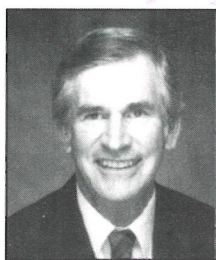
search for holiness. Realizing my own mistakes has made me more understanding about the seeming blindness in other people and in our society. For example, I have always been very serious about life and seen this sobriety as a virtue. I am a natural crusader, desiring to change life for the better. Over time I have come to see that I need balance, to recapture a sense of fun that I lost when I became so serious about religion. I need to let the child come out (to the delight of our children, who sometimes say, "Dad, lighten up!").

These are some of the reasons why I feel as if I'm just beginning. Since I am still learning about so many important things and change is so gradual, I hope God will grant me many more years.

Our goal in life is to love God, and to love people, to be compassionate as our heavenly Father is compassionate. This takes time. Some can become saints in 30 years, for me even 70 years is too short.

We Were Afflicted in Every Way... But Not Crushed

As you probably know, I've just finished writing a book titled *Deliverance from Evil Spirits* (Chosen Books is publishing it in June). That's the good news,



the task was successfully completed.

The writing has been a five-year process that proved a long and arduous undertaking. The project has been hindered by what can only be described as spiritual harassment. It was clear that "our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cos-

mic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places," Ephesians 6:12 NRSV. For example, Ann Bauwens and Betty Heindle, my secretaries over the last five years, would develop headaches when driving into work, or typing the book on computer. When we prayed, the headaches would disappear. Judith and I and the staff experienced computer problems, accidents, illnesses, and other trials we will spare you. It became a joke at lunch, "When are you going to finish **that** book?"

Many of you have been praying very hard for us and standing with us during this time of trial. We could identify with Paul as he states in 2 Corinthians 4:8-9, "We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed," and 2 Corinthians 4:16, "So we do not lose heart. Even though our outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed day by day." God did renew us and prove that

"in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us," Romans 8:37.

In God's protection and grace we finally finished the manuscript and sent it on to my editor at Chosen Books, Jane Campbell, a very level-headed, rational person. "I have to confess I wasn't worried when I received the computer disk for your new book, despite the computer glitches and physical problems that had arisen in your office," Jane writes. But all did not go as planned. Two weeks after receiving the manuscript Jane phoned our office in distress: for no apparent reason the text had disappeared on her computer screen and two weeks' work was lost.

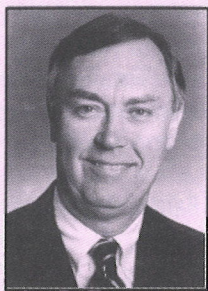
"The prospect of losing all my work reduced me to tears. Plus I was scared. I felt I was up against a presence stronger than I was, and that I was being toyed with. The support man from Microsoft called my problem 'strange' and 'weird' and told me that it was at a level **deeper than the software** and **(Continued on page 7)**

Selections from my mailbag:

I am requesting prayer for my two-and-a-half year old daughter. Our first experience with your ministry was when Christina was born in critical condition five-weeks premature with water on her brain. Various stages of hemorrhaging in the brain were evident, with extensive brain damage.

The doctors did not believe she would live. At this time we were not Christians, but a friend who was called your ministry and requested prayer for Christina, and for the Lord to touch the whole family. Well, the Lord began to touch us. Christina had two unsuccessful surgeries, and the doctors expected her to die. We prayed, were born again, and filled with peace and faith.

We believed that she had been healed although it was not immediately evident; her physical condition was actually worse. We asked the Lord for some sign of the healing. Her head was healed in seconds, and became small. The doctor was shocked, but his outlook was still pessimistic, citing extensive brain damage - a biopsy during the first surgery showed no good new brain tissue. One year later, a CAT-scan revealed a great deal of new brain tissue. Again, he was amazed. We were so thankful.

I feel that a catalyst for all of the above was the prayer of believing people at your ministry, and God does answer prayer. I feel that God is telling me to pray and fast for her complete recovery. Please join me in praying for Christina. I thank God for your ministry and all the prayers.

I have been an intercessor for four-and-a-half years now and have been so blessed that I have shared my praise reports along the way as prayers have been answered! I believe so firmly in the power of prayer, and I praise Jesus for allowing me to minister in this way.

I am amazed at the answered prayers. I requested prayers for a broken relationship, it is now mended—Prayers for two situations where the people needed healing, and they are now completely well with no side effects of their illnesses. I marvel at the wonders of answered prayer. Thank you and all the intercessors that took part in the prayers.

Your prayers for my friend are really having results. She has a disease which causes inflammation of the arteries to the brain that leads to permanent blindness. Her sight has really improved! Thank you so much for the prayers.

My son had been killed in an automobile wreck, and I was no longer able to pray or believe in God. After receiving a copy of *Sword of the Spirit* I prayed the Deliverance Prayer and my deep depression lifted almost immediately. I feel free now and can now pray to God on a regular basis. I thank God for those prayers.

We had called in for prayer for a friend who was being operated on to remove cancerous tumors. When our friend was "opened up" not only was there no cancer, but no tumors! We thank you and all the intercessors for their prayers.

My cousin has had a miracle healing of lymphoma. Thank you for the prayers.

Last June my husband called and asked for prayer for our daughter who was scheduled for spinal surgery to fuse a slipped vertebrae. We asked that you pray for strength and flexibility. I am happy to report that not only did Melissa's surgery go well but at the end of one week in the hospital she got up out of bed and walked without the need of crutches or a walker. I thank God for her continued healing and I thank Him for all your prayers.

Preparation for Ministry

Sometime during my childhood I realized that my life would take a different direction from the lives of my parents and friends. I remember having long talks with God about this. As my life unfolded, it was anything but normal extensive traveling, much learning—incredible people along the way. A preparation, each stage guided by an unseen hand, it was a divine plan for something wonderful.

I made many heart-breaking mistakes along the way, but I was always set right again and was gently nudged to continue - seeking, gathering, preparing. Then my time in Jerusalem—I've called this stage of my life a "graduate course in the Holy Spirit," accelerated learning in healing, deliverance, obedience and discipline. I was blessed with many wonderful teachers, Bob and Margaret Lindsey, Jan Willem VanDeurhoven, Wes Brown, Jamie Buckingham and Francis MacNutt among others.

When it came time to leave Israel, a dear friend of mine Floride Amiel, a seventy-five year old missionary who had lived in Israel for 40 years, called me to her home. She had been praying for me when God gave her a vision of what was to come. She said the ministry and life God had prepared for me was too wonderful for words; it went beyond anything I could ever imagine. She said that she was not at liberty to share it with me, but that I should continue in my preparation. She would only say that thousands would be touched by God through this ministry. Her face was radiant as she

spoke of what she saw.

I must admit I was overwhelmed by what she said, and thought that it was her love for me speaking, not the Lord. Four years later I sent Floride an invitation to our wedding, hoping she could come from Israel to celebrate with us as she was like a mother to me. She couldn't come for the wedding, but she wrote how happy she was for us and sent her blessings. At the end of the letter she wrote four words, "Now it has begun!" Reading

that I remembered the vision she had received and her words, "a ministry too wonderful for words." Not only would Francis and I be joining our hearts and our lives, we would be joining in the work of God's heart—His healing ministry.

Thousands upon thousands have been touched by this ministry and God continues to heal and to transform lives everyday. We just celebrated our fifteenth anniversary. Fifteen years of living in a glorious celebration of life and love: two incredible children, faithful friends and colleagues near and far, loving, loyal supporters of this ministry committed to the restoration of His healing ministry to His church. Numerous books and tapes have been released that reach around the world. There have been so many blessings. Floride was right!

This month we joyfully celebrate Francis' seventieth birthday and his remarkable life. Francis has been in the

ordained ministry since 1956. At a Camp Far Out conference in 1967, he received the release of the Holy Spirit and began his work in the healing ministry soon afterwards. Since then, he has led a life of humble, dynamic service to the church and to God's suffering children. Through his teachings, the ministry of healing has been restored in numerous denominations world-wide. When Agnes Sanford prayed over Francis in the mid-sixties she said that he would be instrumental in bringing back the healing ministry to the church. Since then, he has authored six books on the subject of healing.

His first book, *Healing*, remains a classic to this day and has sold over a million copies. His latest book *Deliverance from Evil Spirits* is due to be released this summer. Francis spends each day doing the things he loves to do: writing, teaching, preaching and praying for the sick. For fifteen years I have been by his side as he has patiently and lovingly spent long hours praying with the sick and those suffering from broken hearts. I continue to marvel at the love and the tenderness he shows to each one who comes for prayer. It is easy for me to see Jesus in this gentle servant of God.

On the home front, he is a wise and loving father—much more patient than Mom! He is truly loved by Rachel and David. He is the kind of dad that will always allow them to see God as their Abba, a tender, merciful, loving presence in their lives. He is my best friend, and a constant source of encouragement, support, and love. I thank God for his birth and his life, a life I have been tremendously privileged to share.
