

### OUR NEED FOR F

#### by Francis MacNutt

Fascinating recent research developments show that if we suffer too much stress over a long period of time, our immune system gives way, and we



tend to become sick. Widowers, for instance, are especially prone to fall sick and to die themselves in the year following upon their wives' deaths. On the other hand, widows don't have as much of a problem, probably because they talk more with friends and deal with their grief openly, thereby reducing stress.

More to the point, for those of us in the healing ministry, psychologists are now studying something called compassion fatigue. You can get worn out "weeping with those who weep," if you don't balance it with "rejoicing with those who rejoice" (Romans 12:15). Most people who get into the caring professions — which includes prayer for healing — tend to have tender hearts and to deeply feel the suffering of others. How often we read that Jesus was motivated to pray for healing because he had "compassion

a man whose life has been devoted to working with psychotic patients; he broke into convulsive sobs and shared that he is often tempted to commit suicide. This is a normal human reaction. When we share in the pain of our suffering world, we can be overcome by the enormity of its evil. And when we see so much suffering, we find it hard to take time out to enjoy life: to go out to dinner, to play tennis, or to watch sunsets. These seem such a waste of time, when Lazarus is starving outside our door (Luke 16:19-31). How can we be so heartless as to leave him, while we go to laugh and play?

The only way I have learned to deal with this guilt is by remembering something I heard many years ago in the seminary: "You have to decide whether your life is a long-distance race or a sprint." Early on I decided that I could ultimately help more people if I treated my life and ministry as a long-distance run (as best I can, realizing that my life's length is up to God to determine), rather than burning myself out. I am a limited human being and the best I can do sometimes is to pass by this one person sitting outside my door so that I

to do more than the Lord might be requiring in a particular situation. One of our staff members said that it seems every time we discern a clear call as a ministry to change our course in some more productive way for the Kingdom, the enemy just rattles a few of the thorniest cases we deal with to have major crises that week, and as we scramble to meet their needs, the agenda that the Lord has revealed goes untended or deferred.

We must learn to ask the Lord if HE has sent the people who come for help at inopportune times, often he has not! Sometimes our pride is appealed to: "I have to talk to you. Only you can help me!" This is just not true. There is only one Savior, and we are not Him. The Lord said in Matthew 11:28-30 KJV, "Come unto me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy

and my burden is light." If we are really chaffing and straining in the harness, and we are finding no rest for our souls, we are probably carrying burdens that he has not given us.

As you can see, wisdom and discernment are crucial in regard to letting God bring balance to our lives so that we can avoid the consequences of burn out. Just this morning I read an article reporting research that showed **stress may make us sick**, and that once we have become sick, **stress may slow down our healing**. This report studied thirteen healthy women who were caring for a relative who was suffering from Alzheimer's disease (they spent

at least seven hours a day in tending to the sick relative's needs.) All these women, in addition to a control group, had undergone a punch biopsy to remove a small pea-sized circle of skin. The surprising result was that the caregivers took an average of eight days longer to heal! Furthermore, these caregivers, who had a built-in difficulty in taking time out to get their own lives in balance, were themselves likely to become seriously ill by the end of the year.

The lesson is that we need to prayerfully take care of ourselves or we won't be around to take care of anyone else.

I know that I am preaching here to

myself, because I still feel a little guilty taking time off. I feel even more guilty in using that time to really enjoy myself and party with friends and family. But Jesus must have done this. Wasn't he accused of being a "winebibber" and criticized for going to too many parties with sinners? (Matthew 11:19, Luke 7:34). Jesus must have been enjoyable to be around or sinners wouldn't have stayed to listen to him.

Fortunately for me, we have here on our staff several happy characters who say to me from time to time: "You don't look like you've been having enough fun lately." They are right. How about you?

## CHM To Participate In Spiritual Research Development

#### Sponsored by the John Templeton Foundation

The John Templeton Foundation is funding a series of three conferences on Spiritual Research Development conducted by The National Institute of Healthcare Research. Francis MacNutt is one of about forty people asked to participate in these conferences that will bring together professionals in the four clinical areas of physical and mental health, addictive disorders, and neurobiological studies.

The inspiration and impetus for the conferences come from Sir John Templeton himself and represents a key step forward in his desire to promote progress in spiritual research across the various scientific disciplines. The purpose of the conference series is to develop research strategy and planning tools to advance the scientific investigation of religious and spiritual factors in the prevention, coping and treatment of physical and mental illness, and addictive disorders, and also investigating how these factors impact neurobiological studies.

Participants must commit to attend all three conferences. It is hoped that the conferences will enable the participants to not only identify the existing barriers to spiritual research in each of the four clinical areas, but that they will be able to develop concrete goals and objectives to overcome these obstacles as well. Participants in each clinical area will cooperate to produce a report detailing their goals, objectives, anticipated problems, and the current state of relative research in their fields, and suggest directions for future study.

Once the objectives and methods of the studies are established, Christian Healing Ministries will be participating in some of the research involving the efficacy of prayer in promoting healing. Needless to say, Francis and CHM feel very honored to be included, and we are all very excited about the opportunity to be a part of such a ground-breaking research effort funded by the highly respected John Templeton Foundation. More information will be forthcoming in the Fall edition of *The Healing Line*.





#### More Intercessors Needed As Prayer Requests Increase

I would like to make a plea for more intercessors to join the Christian Healing Ministry Intercessors to pray for the requests that come into the Center. Lately the number of requests have almost doubled, and the number of intercessors has stayed around 500.

At one time we had eight to ten intercessors praying for each page of requests, and now I have only two or three intercessors praying per page of requests. We are processing around six to seven thousand prayer requests a month. These requests come from letters, phone calls, requests by those we minister to, and lists sent in by prayer groups or other ministries. The requests seem to increase

special needs of CHM, and a few issues that involve our Nation. We use Sword of the Spirit and pray scripture. This keeps us all in one accord, takes the guess work

out of praying, and allows God's power in His Word to be the healing force. If you are led to become an intercessor, please let us know.

We continue to encourage you to start your own prayer group in your church, neighborhood, school, in hospital, retirement homes, and especially in prisons. We have seen some amazing things occur in the last few months as a result of these groups forming. Some people will say "I don't think I am called to intercession." My answer to that is that we are called to be Christ-like and Christ is the great Intercessor.

Years ago, when looking for a scripture text that would describe the task of an intercessor, I opened by accident to Isaiah 62, and I've often used the text in writing or in preaching and then recently a copy of the excellent book Sword of the Spirit fell into my hands. CLICK—the parts all fell together. Your book and my text seem made for each other. The book is made up of God's promises, the Isaiah text calls on us to remind God of his promises. We have been given a voice that He will hear—namely HIS WORD. I look forward to mounting the walls of Jerusalem to do my round of duty!

### The Media and Medical World Show Increasing Focus On The Supernatural and Healing Prayer

Have you noticed? - A startling new development - And a very happy one. Very simply it is this: the supernatural and healing-through-prayer is suddenly appearing in the mass media and in the medical world.

An example of this fascination with the spiritual can be seen in the amazing upsurge of belief in angels! In the past two years scores of books have appeared about angels. Even though some of the new enthusiasm is off center theologically, a large amount of the material generated to feed the public's interest is surprisingly solid, especially when you consider that most current

seminaries do not have courses on angels in their theological curriculum (In spite of the fact that St. Thomas Aguinas had a lengthy section on angels in his theological master-

piece, Summa Theologica, written in the 13th century). Like many of you, Judith and I have taken to watching "Touched by an Angel" on Saturday night TV, and find it profoundly moving and very sound in its presentation of the ministry of angels.

There has also been an increase in acknowledgment of the work of bad angels — the demonic realm. Who writes about them? Well, it's Dr. Scott Peck, the most famous psychiatrist writer in the field today, author of the runaway best seller The Road Less Traveled. His next book was People of the Lie, whose purpose was to show that people really are influenced by personal evil, the demonic realm. So the Church faces this amazing contrast: a brilliant psychiatrist who says that Satan exists and that he has encountered him, while many reputable theologians deny the existence of a personal Satan and the demonic realm altogether. The word "supernatural" itself has also fallen into disrepute among some theologians today. Could it be that the Church is being evangelized by scientists and TV writers?

First, there came the realization that

many bodily sicknesses have a mental or spiritual component. Dr. Bernie Siegel's books (like Love, Medicine and Miracles) propose that cancer, for example, attacks people because something deeper has broken down that lessens their desire to live. And studies done on heart disease seem to show that undirected anger is perhaps the deeper reason underlying some heart attacks.

This psychogenic approach has been gaining strength for perhaps the past 20 years ("psychogenic" doesn't mean that the illness is imaginary, but only that the origin of the physical sickness lies in the person's soul. Some

More pertinent to our ministry in the rising tide of secular interest in things spiritual, has been the medical profession's recent interest in the possibility of prayer impacting healing.

> scientists estimate that 80% of sickness is psychogenic in origin!).

> But now in the last five years perhaps, comes a further development: alternative medicine.1 You may have heard that Harvard held a seminar about six months ago on alternative medicine attended by nearly a thousand people including 180 physicians!

> This changing attitude among medical professionals is expressed in books like Dr. Larry Dossey's Healing Words, which summarizes more than one hundred scientific studies that show the importance of prayers contribution to healing. Dr. Dossey claims that the research is overwhelmingly positive in demonstrating the value of prayer. Then Leonard Laskow, MD, does research indicating that love has healing power. He became so excited that he sold his gynecological practice and went into full-time research on the healing power of love.

> Even more amazing: insurance companies (like Mutual of Omaha) are funding studies on the value of alternative medicine. Financially, it is much more cost effective to get someone healed through prayer in comparison

to having an operation. Is this the modern example of the children of this world being wiser than the children of light? This is not to say that all methods of alternative medicine being advocated or explored are acceptable to Christians. Some definitely are not. It is a shame that the world lumps Christian healing prayer under the category of alternative medicine along with New Age and in some cases ancient healing rituals and practices.

Now, some of these studies are not about Christian prayer, but even those that are not seem to show the wonderful forces that God has created in this world to heal us. In this way, the

> medical world is discovering that in addition to medicine and surgery, we also have healing available through love and community, and the reduction of stress through meditation.

This should give Christians an impetus to share with the world what Jesus can do when we ask for healing and deliverance. And this is exactly what is happening. Right now at CHM we are discussing plans with several research scientists for doing studies on the effects of prayer on patients in a clinical setting. Beyond the reduction of stress and other such benefits, we believe (and have seen) that far more happens when we ask Jesus to heal us, extraordinary healings that we do not think can be explained simply by the power of suggestion or the presence of human love: tumors disappear, crooked bones straighten and people are freed from evil spirits. This is what we know and see, that trust in Jesus Christ and his desire to heal God's children is crucial to our health and happiness. After the suffering of Lent, we truly share - even, to some extent, in this life in the Resurrection power of Easter!

<sup>1</sup>Alternative Medicine includes all forms of healing other than standard medical treatment; it includes such diverse methods as acupuncture, shamanism, Transcendental Meditation and Christian prayer.

#### **Rising Circulation and Expenses**
