


A Question for You

Years of praying for healing has taught us so much, and our experience has taught us many things we never learned from books. For example, most of you know about “soaking prayer,” the amount of time that is usually needed to bring healing to the sick. Experience taught us about soaking prayer, and now most healing ministers accept that particular teaching, since it agrees both with Scripture and experience. What was once new has become old.

Now, here are two new insights for you to consider as a possibility—let us know what you think.

1. Getting someone else to pray for you is more effective than praying for yourself.

There are several reasons for this: one is that when we are sick, the pain is often so great that it is hard to raise our spirits and our thoughts out of our own distress. When we are sick, it is hard to be positive, to believe that the pain might instantly be lifted—or ever be lifted. We desire more faith than that, but sickness and negative feelings tend to occupy the center of our attention, in spite of ourselves. The friend who prays for and with us can usually, more easily, hear the Lord’s guidance and be positive about healing than we can.

Then, too, as you know, with the laying on of hands, we often feel the surge of God’s power as it moves from one person to the other.

In Scripture, we also see the example of Jesus—and also the 12 (Matthew 10) and the 72 (Luke 10)—who didn’t just preach to the sick encouraging them to pray for themselves, but who spent hours laying their hands on the sick and praying for them. Wouldn’t it have been so much easier if they had just taught hundreds at a time, showing them how to pray for themselves. Jesus really does seem to be more present when at least two or three are gathered to pray.

2. Getting somebody outside your family to pray for you is sometimes more effective than praying within your family.

Now, we are enthusiastically in favor of praying in the family, and I even wrote a book *The Prayer that Heals* to show how it can be done! Furthermore, we know of many wonderful healings that have taken place when families pray.

But there do seem to be times when God leads us to ask for outside help. In our own family, the clearest sign of this came when our daughter, Rachel, was healed of severe asthma 12 years ago. Judith and I had been praying for Rachel for seven years with no sign of progress, when two friends (Emmy Cerveny and Pat Novak) prayed for her one night. Rachel was instantly healed, and it has lasted.

Why should this be? What sense does it make (aside from humbling us)?

There are several good reasons. One reason, that we have known for a long time is that certain people are specially gifted in some areas of healing—like medical specialists, and we need to turn to them when we are faced with a particularly difficult prayer need. I think we all realize that.

But I think there is another, more hidden reason. It becomes evident, when I consider that my own family has been gifted by God with a healing ministry: for instance, we have prayed for many outside our home who had asthma and they were healed. And we have prayed within the family for ailments that ordinarily get healed when we pray for others—yet they were not healed. How do we explain this, other than chalking it up to mystery? On the other hand, one major miracle (the healing of cancer) happened when I prayed for Judith, but it occurred before we married; in fact, when I hardly knew her.

The reason is, I believe, that God wants to move us out of our isolation, not just as individuals, but even as families, and wants us to depend upon the wider human community. Our society is so isolated, so independent, that He wants us to recognize how dependent we should be upon our friends, upon our church and upon other Christians. It's the same point that Paul is making in I Corinthians 12 when he says that the Spirit distributes different gifts to different members of the community so that we have to turn outside ourselves to others: the eye can no longer say to the foot, "I don't need you."

Since God wants to heal our relationships, our churches, our cities, he is kicking us out of the nest, as it were—motivating us to reach out to others, not only to help them, but to be helped by others outside our group, to receive the healing we need.

It's God stating emphatically, "No man is an island."

Healing News

In the last issue of *The Healing Line* we devoted an entire page to what appeared to be a major breakthrough in the deliverance ministry, when the International Order of Exorcists announced a conference on exorcism in Malta in October. They were hoping for 1,000 people to attend, which would have marked an astonishing change in attitude—much more acceptance than ever before. Then the announcement came that the conference has been canceled due to “unforeseen circumstances.” From what we understand, the 1,000 registrations they were hoping for did not materialize, and so they had to cancel.

A Healing of ALS

Often we are asked whether we have ever seen certain very serious illnesses healed, such as Down's Syndrome (we do know of one). One of the sicknesses we are asked about is ALS (*Lou Gehrig's disease*). Back in 1977 our team prayed in Toledo, Ohio, for a woman who had ALS and she was notably improved, although not totally healed, in the two days' time our teams prayed with her, but, so far as we know, she was not totally healed. (If you wish to see what happened to her, her partial healing is captured on our video “The Healing Ministry in the Church.”)

Well, finally, I met a man who has been healed of ALS. His name is Don Jaeger (from Winter Park, FL), and he was kind enough to write out a description of his healing from which I take the following salient points. During the summer of 1992 he was diagnosed with ALS, which is ordinarily fatal and whose downward progress is steady and irretrievable. (Two of the top experts in central Florida, an EMG specialist and a neurologist, agreed upon the diagnosis.) Then Don went to hear Canon Jim Glennon (author of *Your Healing is Within You*) and came to believe in Jesus' healing him of ALS. They prayed for him at his church and he had his first religious experience—a warmth and peace—that convinced him that he would be cured. He continued to seek medical counsel and physical therapy, as well as attending weekly healing services at his church. During this time, he continued to believe that he was being healed, and, while waiting in a neurologist's office, he received what he felt was an irrefutable sign that he was healed when he became very warm and a “total encompassing, utter peace came over my body.” A month later, he asked for a sign that he had been cured and that time would prove it. He was at his physical therapy session,

and they asked him to lift some weight with only his lower legs to establish a base-line for further exercises. With his lower leg weakened through muscular atrophy, and with absolutely “no strain, or hanging on to handles, I lifted the maximum weight of 220 pounds. This word flew all over the center.” Later he went to the Cleveland Clinic, one of the best hospitals in the U.S. specializing in ALS. The doctors there put him through three hours of tests and one said, “The people in Florida may not believe me, but I see over 150 cases of ALS a year and you show no signs of ever having had ALS.” Don then threw away his brace and went snow skiing. “As a reminder of my illness, I still have a weakness and pain in my left leg and right hand.” After his healing he dealt with fear that the ALS would return but “through God's help I no longer have that fear.” So, praise God, this is the first report I have ever received on the healing of ALS. (Don says he knows of another man who was also healed of ALS.)

The following is a fascinating news item taken from *The Tablet* (an English Catholic weekly magazine). Since we are learning more and more about generational healing and being set free from familiar (ancestral) spirits, I share it with you to add to your information on this controversial topic.

George Frederic Handel's House

In England, the *Sunday Telegraph* reported that an unnamed priest was to exorcise the London House in which the great composer George Frederic Handel had lived. A fund-raiser for the Handel House Trust reported seeing a ghost, thought to be of a woman, in the bedroom where the composer had died in 1759. A Catholic priest was quoted as saying that “This is a soul who is restless and not at home.”

Later, however, a spokesperson for the Trust stated, “Although a presence has been felt by members of the staff in the bedroom, which includes a floral aroma, the Handel House Trust has no intention of contacting a priest or organizing an exorcism.” A Jesuit expert in London, Fr. Francis Edwards, was contacted by *The Tablet* but was not aware of any priest being asked to perform the exorcism, but he added, “I have no doubt that ghosts exist. People in that state are those who have clung too hard to life, because of some resentment or desire for revenge. I would say they are in purgatory but can be moved on.”

Francis and Judith MacNutt Training Center

In carrying out its mission, Christian Healing Ministries has developed a training program in order to train and equip individuals who are interested and/or feel called to our Lord's ministry of Healing Prayer. The first area of training is offered through CHM's School of Healing Prayer Levels I, II, III and IV. The second area of training is provided through the School of Healing Prayer Practicum and the most advanced area of training is through the School of Healing Prayer Internship Program.

The School of Healing (SHP) Prayer is designed to teach individuals, churches, prayer groups and other Christian organizations about Healing Prayer. The SHP Level I prayer training course includes a foundational, balanced

deliverance. Level IV is currently being developed and will be the most advanced course. When studying the School of Healing Prayer, it is very important to take each level in sequence, as each course builds upon the previous one. Each level will be taught on campus once per year and will include evening practice prayer sessions. Francis and Judith MacNutt are featured speakers at all of the Schools of Healing Prayer. Also, SHP Levels I, II and III may be ordered either by video or audio through the CHM bookstore.


CHM's SHP Practicum is designed to provide a supervised format for the practice of healing prayer. The practicum is offered to prayer ministers who have completed Level I or higher of the School of Healing Prayer. The purpose of the practicum is to have hands-on practice in healing prayer ministry, with supervision of various aspects of the SHP training. For example, participants will be split into small groups where they may practice prayer for inner healing, prayer for the healing of the conception to birth experience, prayer for physical healing and forgiveness prayers. A brief teaching and opportunity to ask questions regarding ministry also will be offered.

CHM's SHP Prayer Internship Program is the most advanced area of training. It is designed to offer students in-depth prayer ministry training on a firsthand basis. This program provides those who have studied CHM's School of Healing Prayer Levels I, II and III an opportunity to exercise the teaching and tools they have learned and to further their training while under the authority and direction of CHM staff and prayer ministers. Internship programs are individually and uniquely designed for specific groups, such as ordained ministers, members of the medical profession, and lay leaders in the healing ministry. The Internship Program is especially helpful for lay leaders or clergy who are interested in establishing a healing ministry.

The Level II School of Healing Prayer builds on the foundations established in Level I. Level II leads prayer ministers through a progressive and more in-depth understanding of the healing ministry and more specific issues that arise. It focuses on the healing of relationships through more defined areas such as healing of marriage, healing wounds of divorce, and healing of abortion and miscarriage, among others. Level III was created to address issues that very experienced prayer ministers may encounter, such as abuse, addictions, homosexuality and

Praise Reports from God's Children:

While my daughter was here from out of state to help me recover from arthroscopic surgery, she received a call informing her that her ten year old son (Kirk) had passed out and fallen on his face at recess during school. The E. R. findings showed no facial damage, however, "they discovered a brain tumor with a cyst the size of a tangerine growing next to it on his brain. We immediately began to pray and take authority over the enemies attempt to destroy this young life..."

"Thursday, Sep. 28th, I called CHM and put Kirk on the intercessors list for prayer for physical healing and for peace for the family. We also contacted churches, prayer groups and friends."

October 2: "...Kirk's 4 hr. surgery to remove the tumor and cyst began...the report came back to us that surgery was successful, but all of the tumor could not be removed since it was located on his brain stem. To totally remove it would probably cause loss of speech and swallowing. Of course this was not the result we had been praying for but soon realized that God wasn't finished yet and we needed to stand in faith believing He still wanted to perform His miracle. The Dr. said Kirk would have to go through radiation and chemo to try to get rid of the remaining tumor."

October 5: "...a neuro-oncologist was called in to evaluate and program Kirk's further treatment. The first tests to be completed were another MRI and CAT Scan; these results were absolutely astonishing. There was no sign of any remaining tumor, the scans were completely clear. There would be no need for chemo or radiation. When my daughter received the news, she ran throughout the hospital, telling everyone that God had just miraculously healed her son. The Dr. who had performed the surgery reconfirmed his first prognosis that he had not been able to remove all of the tumor and that further treatment would be necessary."

October 7: Kirk left the hospital and on the 10th he returned to school. He is functioning as before.

"God is so awesome. His healing grace is still a mystery, why some are healed and others are not, but He is in control and we shall ever be thankful and grateful for this our miracle."

"I wish to tell of a personal experience my wife and I had 20 years ago that proved to us, beyond any shadow of a doubt, that prayer, especially when combined with the power of love, can achieve anything you could ever hope for.

My wife had been experiencing several months of discomfort in the area of her abdomen. She described it as a dull pain. As time went on, she began to be easily winded; a walk of 50-75 yards would require that she stop and rest. She decided it was time to see a doctor. The day we visited the doctor is one that I will never forget. After extensive tests he called us into his office and told us the bad news in these words: "I'm afraid your worst fears are about to be realized. Your wife must be hospitalized as quickly as I can make arrangements." When we asked what the problem was, he said that my wife had stopped producing blood.

To this day, that was the only diagnosis ever used in describing her ailment. However, we were too stunned to ask any further questions. (I have since been told that from my description of the illness, it was most likely Leukemia.)

Later, I went into a church to pray. As I was leaving the church I picked up a couple of pamphlets and a book on the power of prayer to heal sickness. I read something that changed my life forever. I read that prayer said with unshakable faith will heal any sickness. I read that it is our duty and privilege to pray for the sick to be healed.

The book that influenced me the most was one written by Francis MacNutt. It is titled 'The Prayer That Heals: Praying for Healing in the Family.' Here are some of the lines I read that most encouraged me: 'What God would like to do for and through you is so wonderful that you may find it hard to believe! God wants ordinary people like you to bless and heal each other in your families. When you start to pray with others, amazing things will happen to you and to your loved ones. I want to encourage you to believe a truth that Christians today are often too cynical to believe: Jesus will heal his people through your prayers.'

... I went home and the next day, Saturday, I called my wife and children together for a family meeting in the living room. I shared with them some of Francis' book and told them that I was going to pray that mother be healed and that I had every expectation that she would be. I believe my exact words were that we were to 'pray without ceasing until mom was healed.' Now, as you can imagine, this is risky business. If their mom was not healed, their faith could be severely damaged. No one, especially a parent, wants to take on that responsibility. But I was confident that my wife would be healed. . .

so that the Father may be glorified.

Four days after the dreadful prognosis by the doctor, I had my hand on my wife's abdomen and was praying quietly when something unusual happened. Throughout this illness my wife's pulse had been rapid and I often felt it pounding under my hand. It started out that way this time as well, but all of a sudden I noticed that her pulse was quiet. I could barely feel it. I looked over at her and noticed she had gone to sleep.

The next morning I did not mention the experience of the night before. I did not want to influence her in any way, but I was sure a healing had taken place. At about noontime my wife came over to me and said: 'Honey, I do not have that pain anymore.' It was then that I told her of the experience of the night before and that I was sure she had been healed. Of course, we kept the appointment with the doctor the next day anyway.

Well, the doctor examined her and ran all sorts of tests. He then called us into his office and holding up two sets of materials (papers and x-rays) said: 'I do not know what is going on here, but this person (holding up one set of materials) is not the same person as this one (holding up the other set of materials).' He could find nothing wrong with my wife! He said that if we wanted to admit my wife for a more thorough examination, he would; but honestly he did not see any reason why he should. We declined the offer to admit her.

The doctor said that my wife was somewhat anemic, and had her take some iron pills for three weeks. After three weeks we went back for a follow-up examine and he said that everything was absolutely normal and there was no need for any more visits. He was completely perplexed by the whole affair. I told him of the prayer experience and his reply was: 'I do not know anything about that, but I know that the person I saw was not the same person that doctor so-and-so saw!' That was that! There was never a reoccurrence of this illness."






