Heart to Heart

From time to time when we are ministering to people who have come forward for prayer, the person for whom we are praying will suddenly fall to the floor and then roll on his or her side in a fetal position. That individual may cry out something like, "I'm not going to come out. I'm not going to be born!" When this voice comes from a 40-year old man, it is always startling, although we have seen this happen often enough.

The most likely explanation is that something went wrong way back in the womb, and we need to pray and ask Jesus to help him be "born again" in this particular way, And it does happen.

When Judith and I were writing Praying for Your Unborn Child, we found that infants in the womb seem to sense whether they are loved (especially by the mother), or whether they are rejected. If parents are ambivalent about whether or not they want the child, the infant also seems to be able pick up on that. This love—or its absence—seems to equip the child with a healthy sense of his or her existence in the world or with a feeling of being a mistake. We have prayed for many adults whom the Lord has healed of this deep sense of rejection.

The late Dr. Frank Lake, a British Christian psychiatrist, wrote that, in his experience, the most dangerous time in our lives for developing a deep tendency towards psychosis is during our first three months in utero!


Now this is a deep mystery, for we know that the brain isn't formed in those early weeks of our lives. Therefore, the infant in those early weeks is not yet able to receive thoughts or ideas, so it seems impossible for all this to happen.

One possibility, though, is that even before our minds are fashioned in utero—and forever afterwards—our hearts (our spirits) are able to know and experience love long before we can process ideas. If Jesus placed such an



emphasis upon loving one another, and if receiving love is so important to our happiness, it makes sense to believe

that our spirits (our hearts) can both give and receive love from the very beginning. (Recently, many scientists and psychologists have begun to think in these terms).



As I said in my article last month, our main desire should not be merely to receive the ministry gifts, such as the gift of healing, but to experience the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u>, such as love, joy, and peace. We should not only desire the gifts demonstrating God's power, but we should yearn to be like Jesus: "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me" (Gal. 2:20a). Not only will love intuitively communicate itself to everyone, but it will also heal.

News Items

Since CHM's mission is in large part the reconciliation of hostile groups, and since Iraq has been so much in our news, I think our readers would like to know that there are nearly 800,000 Christians living in Iraq, the largest number of Christians living in any Arab country. Of these, 350,000 live in Baghdad, and most belong to the ancient Chaldean Catholic Church, an Eastern-rite church which still uses Aramaic D the language Jesus spoke D as its official language.

During Saddam's regime, these Christians were tolerated, but the predominant Shi'ites have, for the most part, an ideal of an all-Islamic state that would not tolerate Christians. Preachers from United States-based Christian groups are "triggering a backlash of Muslim fundamentalism," according to The Tablet (Aug. 30, 2003), a Christian magazine published in England. The Latin-rite Catholic Archbishop of Baghdad complained that "American evangelists' attempts to convert Muslims included haranguing people on the streets and asking for money. This is creating an impossible atmosphere which, by offending the sensibility of the people, fosters the development of extremism."

As we all know, our beloved country belongs to a tragi-

cally fallen world in which we were raining down bombs, not only on Muslims but on thousands of fellow Christians; and what one group of Christians does to convert Muslims leads other Christians to danger for their lives. How as Christians can we be agents of reconciliation?

Marriage Weekend

We just had the happy experience of taking part in a most remarkable weekend (Sept. 26-27). Sponsored by Mastering Life Ministries (Rev. David Kyle Foster) and CHM, John and Paul Sanford joined Judith and me in putting on a conference for the healing of marriage relationships. The response was extraordinary, as 650 people (most of them from outside Jacksonville) came to the Performing Arts Center in downtown Jacksonville, Florida. The remarkable part of it all was not that a conference on marriage was held, but rather that so many deep healings of relationships took place because of God's presence throughout—the music ministry (the Cathedral Church of the Messiah's group), the talks, the prayers from the platform and the individual prayers of devoted prayer ministers that lasted until after midnight on Saturday.


Here are some typical reports:

Framework for Developing a Healing Ministry: Part Two

In this issue we will examine how to select and effectively train prayer ministers for a healing ministry. We will specifically address the personal attributes of a prayer minister, some essential requirements to establish, along with helpful suggestions when conducting a prayer ministry training class.

Personal Attributes of Prayer Ministers

Most of the people that are called into a healing ministry will exhibit the following characteristics:

- 1. They are able to express unconditional love.
- 2. They are not judgmental.
- 3. They are able to keep confidences.
- 4. They are sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit.
- 5. They are able to attentively listen.
- 6. They have a compassionate heart.
- 7. They are always able to offer hope.
- 8. They are willing to come under the authority of leadership and able to take correction well.
- 9. They have a healthy image of God.

It is helpful to keep these qualities in mind before prayerfully inviting someone to be a prayer minister.

Requirements for Prayer Ministers

In order to establish an effective prayer ministry, it is essential to adhere to certain requirements. Below is a list of the requirements that CHM has found helpful for every prayer minister:

- 1. Has a personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 2. Believes in the power of prayer: A prayer minister usually has strong and consistent prayer life.

- 3. Believes in the authority of Scripture and has a good understanding of the Christian faith.
- 4. Has received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit or is open to receiving.
- 5. Lives a Christian lifestyle.
- 6. Believes that God is calling them to this ministry.

Training Prayer Ministers

Christian Healing Ministries has developed a comprehensive training program in order to train and equip individuals who are interested in and feel called to pray. We know that there is not a standardized formula to pray for healing, and that Jesus is the one who heals, however, the training program does relay many powerful lessons, tools and Biblical principles that God has taught us during the course of the many years in this ministry.

The training program is comprised of three schools that include approximately twelve teachings. It is important that each level is taken in sequence.

SHPTM Level I: This particular school includes a foundational and balanced approach to begin a prayer ministry. It teaches the student how to effectively minister prayer for healing within a Biblical framework.

SHPTM Level II: This school builds on the foundations established in Level I. It leads prayer ministers through a progressive and more in–depth understanding of the healing ministry.

SHPTM Level III: This school was created to address issues that very experienced prayer ministers may encounter, such as abuse, addictions and difficult situations where deliverance is needed.

Each class will take approximately three hours. The first half of the class should include the video teaching as well as a questions and answer session. The second half of the class should be comprised of prayer time. It should take approximately one year to complete all three levels.

CHM has found the prayer time to be a critical component of the training. By the end of three months (this is usually how long it takes to complete SHP Level I) each student should have received ample opportunity to receive healing prayer, as well as receive experience in praying for others. C.H.M. also recommends that each student read the following:

- 1. Healing by Francis MacNutt
- 2. Deliverance from Evil Spirits by Francis MacNutt
- 3. Praying for Your Unborn Child by Judith and Francis MacNutt

- ❖ Heidi Scanlan, who had suffered with Fibromyalgia for ten years, came to CHM last spring, was prayed for, and received healing. Here is what she told us: "I was driving down Wisconsin Avenue in Georgetown (D.C.) when I saw a woman on the sidewalk who was walking the way I used to walk, obviously in pain and having a hard time putting one foot in front of the other. I pulled over, asked her how far she was going, and said, 'If you don't mind riding with a stranger, I would be happy to give you a ride.' The woman thanked Heidi, got into the car, and said, 'Yes, I am having a hard time walking. I have something you probably have never heard of, a debilitating disease called fibromyalgia.' Heidi said, 'Oh, I know. I had it for ten years, then I went to Christian Healing Ministries in Jacksonville and got healed. A friend who went with me received inner healing, and I was healed of my fibromyalgia. Where do you live?' When the woman replied that she lived about an hour's drive from Jacksonville, Heidi said, 'You don't have to live with all that pain any longer. Go to Christian Healing Ministries for prayer. I'm not completely healed; I have to take something for pain once in a while, but whereas I used to have to take four or five pills a day in order to function, now, praise God, I rarely take any medicine.' That meeting, I'm sure, was no coincidence; it was God working." (Heidi is an active young mother of two and the new director of ALPHA in Washington, D.C.)
- Tina B. dropped by CHM to inquire about enrolling in the School of Healing Prayer Level I. She shared her own story of healing: "Several years ago I injured my back.
