

Can the Healing Ministry Help Us Become Holy?

This is a word of hope for those of you in the healing ministry. This hope is simply that this wonderful ministry can be a great help in drawing you closer to God.

At first glance this may seem questionable, since the ministry has some obvious pitfalls. The “star” system is an obvious danger. If you have a well-known, popular ministry, there may be the danger of the crowd’s (or even an individual’s) adulation. People may even try to “touch the hem of your garment,” as it were. If you are on the platform, the spotlight will be on you. Some healers dress in a way to attract attention. (And that may not be all bad. Remember Kathryn Kuhlmann?) Spectacular things may happen when you pray. For instance, people may fall over when you pray for them. You may be tempted to take all this attention too seriously.

I remember a conference of Christian leaders I attended with Judith many years ago, and her immediate

response to those famous (some of them) leaders whom she never had met before was that they looked like peacocks strutting around, proud of the size and success of their churches and ministries.

So it’s very possible that the healing ministry can become a temptation to pride.

But if we have any real sense of God’s Spirit, the healing ministry should help rather than hinder us in drawing close to God. As soon as we pray, not only in crowds, but for individuals (in hospitals, for example), we have to face the question of why so many wonderful, sick Christians do not seem to be healed. Very soon it becomes clear that we are not in control, but it all depends on God. I think, if we are honest, our pride soon will be destroyed.

Then, when we see the joy on the radiant face of a sick person who has just been healed, we become instantly aware of how good Jesus is and how much he loves us.

I know when I was younger I used to be very critical and judgmental. I had high Christian standards, and it seemed that there were a lot of failing people out there who didn’t even seem to try. I knew Jesus had told us not to judge, but it was hard not to. The evidence of the devastation caused by sin was all around. How could I not judge?

But once you have really gotten into the ministry of inner healing and you hear the stories of God's wounded people – how they have suffered abuse, how their hearts have been wounded — and how they have been abandoned and rejected, you begin to wonder how they have even managed to survive. You begin to wonder at how well they have done, considering how they have been surrounded by poverty and disastrous relationships. Instead of judging people harshly, you start to praise God for bringing salvation into an apparently hopeless situation. It goes even beyond “There but for the grace of God go I.” Soon it becomes “If I had the kind of life this person had, I probably wouldn’t have made it at all.”

Rather than judging the sin in others, the healing ministry helps us see the sparks of life and hope that most people don’t even glimpse. Instead of lifting us up in pride, the healing ministry should drop us down on our knees in the wonder of how beautifully God’s strength now becomes visible in our human pain and weakness.

P.S. Providentially, Easter Sunday many years ago was the date that Judith's dad was baptized, and she believes he was waiting for Easter before leaving this world.

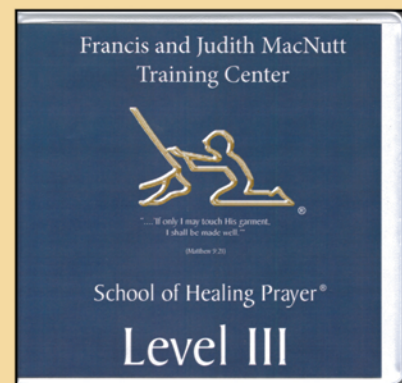
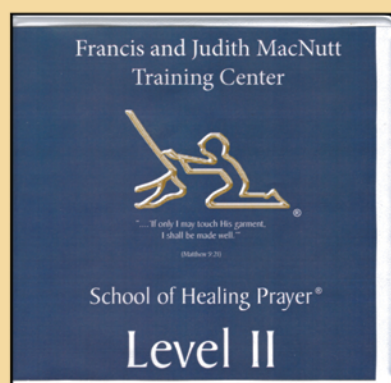
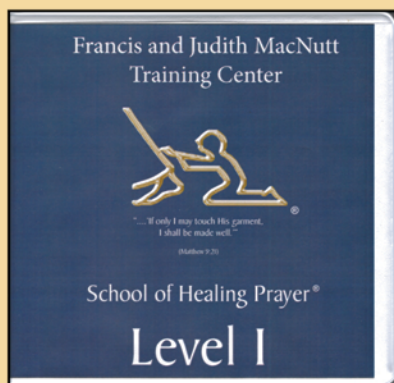

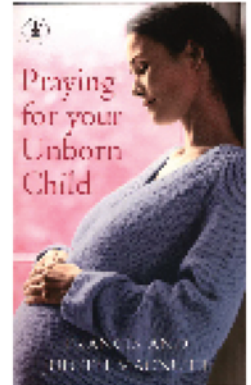
Unborn Babies Affected by Stress of 9/11 Attacks

Pregnant women who escaped the burning Twin Towers four years ago passed on the stress of that awful experience to their unborn infants in a “ripple effect,” according to New York’s Mount Sinai Hospital. Researchers studied 38 expectant mothers who survived the disaster, to find whether by measuring the level of the stress hormone cortisol in their saliva they showed any signs of post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). Reduced levels of cortisol indicate a person is more likely to be vulnerable to PTSD.

The Trade Center mothers who developed anxiety had markedly lower levels of cortisol, and their babies also showed

the same patterns. These findings suggest that the biological affects of trauma “may have to do with very early parent-child attachments and possibly even in-utero effects.” (*The Washington Times*, May 5, 2005, p. A3.)

In relation to inner healing, this bears out our own experience of the need, at times, to pray for what happens to us before birth. (cf. our book *Praying for Your Unborn Child* — go to page thirteen for ordering information).



Prayer in Silence



Mother Teresa, when asked by an interviewer what she says to God when she prays, answered: “I don’t say anything. I just listen.” When the interviewer asked what she hears God say, Mother Teresa replied: “He doesn’t say anything. He just listens. And if you can’t understand that, I can’t explain it to you.”

In Christian tradition this is called the “Prayer of Quiet” – a listening beyond words. In that silence we know and are known by God.

Our conclusion is that without real transformation many Christians live very much like non-Christians.



Prayer and Church may Slow Alzheimer’s

Canadian and Israeli researchers offer evidence that prayer may slow the insidious advance of Alzheimer’s disease. Worldwide, Alzheimer’s affects 5% of adults over 65 and 50% of those over 85. Dr. Yakir Kaufman (director of neurology at Sarah Herzog Memorial Hospital in Jerusalem) writes that “Alzheimer’s patients with higher levels of religiosity may have a significantly slower progression of cognitive decline.”

“This is amazing research,” says Dr. Michael Rayel, chief of psychiatry at Dr. G. B. Cross Memorial Hospital in Clarendville, New Foundland.

Since 4.5 million adults in the U.S. suffer from Alzheimer’s at a cost of \$61 billion

annually, this finding is significant. Whether the prayer is the most important element, rather than just being a part of the patient’s other mental activities is still a major question. “Is prayer simply a heightened cognitive process or does it have unique benefits all its own?” is a question one researcher asks.

We at CHM often are asked about whether we know of positive results when we pray for Alzheimer’s. We have been told about one patient who apparently was healed of Alzheimer’s, and now we have this new research from scientists encouraging us to pray for the effects of aging. (Article in “Science and Theology News,” June 2005, pp. 7-8).

- ◆ “I was delivered from many harmful things of my childhood lodged deep within me — evil spirits that had had a hold on me for a long time. I have stepped into becoming a new creation, transformed by God’s love, and have been equipped to show others God’s love in a more comprehensive way.”

From Emerging Leaders in Healing Conference, July 2005:

- ◆ “All the teachings were wonderful. Fantastic!!!”
- ◆ From Rev. Carola: “I come from a background of many generations of occult practices, with strong influence from my mother. In May of 2004, I attended the Emerging Leaders in Healing conference in Jacksonville. Francis and Judith prayed for deliverance from generational bondage for me. I was set free from this bondage and from the great fear that came with it. My relationship with my mother changed. I felt a deeper love for her and compassion rather than fear. I prayed for her in a new way. When I went to visit her in May of this year, we related differently and had a delightful visit. (During the previous months she had begun to seek Jesus.) On a day when we visited friends, my mother turned to them and made a profession of faith. That same day she fell down a flight of stairs and died. I know the freedom from bondage set my mother free to believe. Praise God!”
- ◆ From Mark: “My wife and I have been part of a prayer team at our church for more than two years. However, when you told us we would be breaking up into small groups to pray for each other for physical healing, my reaction was one of panic. My impulse was to head for the door. At church, the expectations had been low: people might feel better, but actual physical healing? Very unlikely. At this conference the expectation was exactly opposite, and I was scared — afraid that something *would* happen. By the grace of God, I overcame my fears, joined two other men, and we prayed. For the first time, I not only had faith in my head but could feel in my gut that God could use me to do a real physical healing that couldn’t be explained by power of suggestion. I felt that He really wanted to do this. The man with whom we prayed was a runner who, because of an ankle injury, had not been able to run for months. We prayed, and all the pain left his ankle. He was stunned and amazed. The next morning he ran three miles! No pain! Thank you, God! He really, really does want to heal us, and I believe he works through people (like even me!) to do it because we also get healed in the doing. Thank you, God!”
- ◆ From Rev. Ellen, with regard to her experience at Thursday evening prayer time: “As Francis was singing in the Spirit, I heard his song in stanzas: the singing of someone out in the desert, lost and alone, not knowing the way home; then the lost one’s father, weeping and crying for his son to come home, and sending his other son out to find the lost one and bring him back. At the end of the singing, I found myself wailing and crying uncontrollably.

Over the past several months, I had been praying for release from anger that had been passed down through four or five generations. As people near me in that prayer time began praying with me, I experienced deep despair with the terrible sense of having been lost, abandoned. I felt the pain and fear that had been in my mother's family for generations. The Lord lifted all this from me. The maternal side of my family is German, and the words I had for all this were in German. A friend who speaks like a native German sat next to me. As she prayed for me, I said, 'Verloren,' which means 'lost,' and she replied, 'Erfunden,' which means 'found.' I have a wonderful sense that all the old anger has been lifted off me. We are not lost; we are found."

From our mail and email:

- ◆ An updated praise report from Rachel: "In October 2001, I contacted your intercessors for prayer for my husband, Kenneth, age 67. Medically speaking, he was expected to die within a year, and as a last resort had been sent to Shands hospital for a heart transplant. The surgery, a 4-way bypass, was long, and he was in cardiac intensive care for three weeks. Prayers continued. In 2003, a pacemaker was implanted. The last test showed his heart functioning 30–35 percent. The doctors continue to be amazed. We have witnessed to many throughout this ordeal. Had he been healed instantaneously, we would not have seen a brilliant doctor change his attitude after hearing again and again my husband's continual witness in the ensuing years, nor would we have had the opportunity to pray with and witness to those whom God sent. My husband now is mowing grass and tending a small vegetable garden — something he loves but has not been able to do for years. Little did I know, when I first began studying inner healing in the late 1980's, that your healing ministry whose works I have studied would play such a significant role in our lives. Glory to our wonderful God who delights in amazing us.
- ◆ From Joan: "When I was diagnosed with multiple myeloma cancer, in July 2004, my sister gave me a copy of Healing by Francis MacNutt. It helped me immensely and led me to attend many healing services. In December, I learned that the cancer was gone and I had been blessed with substantial healing of the bones. Praise God. 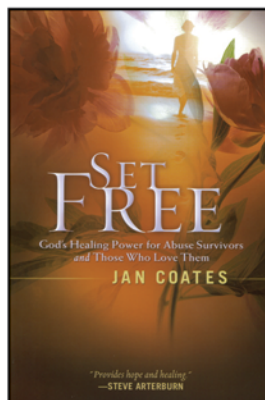

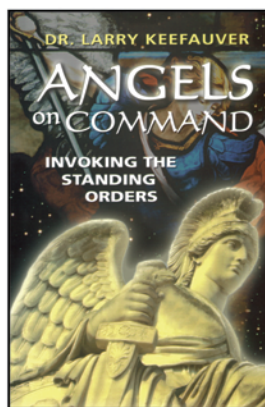
Invoking the Standing Orders
