When I first began to pray to heal the sick in 1967, I was regarded as unusual. "Are you a faith healer?" was the incredulous question I was sometimes asked.

So much has changed for the better since those days. Although not all priests and ministers have learned to pray for healing the sick, there are now many who hold healing services or who visit hospitals and pray for the sick. The entire scene has changed, and we at Christian Healing Ministries are very grateful to be part of this wonderful, extraordinary wave of change. And so the *good news* is that many Christians - including lay people - now pray with expectant faith for healing.

What is still needed, however, is for all Christians, the successors of the 72 nameless disciples sent out by Jesus, "He made them welcome and talked to them about the kingdom of God; and he cured those who were in need of healing" (Luke 9:11B), to realize that this happy privilege of healing the sick belongs to them. As you know, this is the basic mission that Christian Healing Ministries proclaims and teaches.

Nevertheless, the ordinary accepted understanding of most Christians in our day is that the age of miracles is now past. This disbelief is reflected in the delightful book, *Children's Letters to God*. One letter states:

"Dear God, how come you did all those miracles in the old days and don't do any now? - Seymour"

As Jesus saw it, healing was destroying the rule of evil upon the human race and was a sign that the kingdom of God was now "at hand." Our exciting mission at CHM is to become empowered by the Holy Spirit and to bring in the kingdom of God. Our ultimate goal is to make the kingdom of God a reality in our world.

This mission is urgent and we believe that God has given us this mission!

We are really excited as we now move forward to build our new healing center! Those of you who have visited Christian Healing Ministries recently and had to find parking two blocks away certainly realize our need for a larger facility. Even on not-so-busy days, our parking lot fills up quickly and the rooms for ministry are cramped. Our devoted CHM staff members work in crowded quarters because we have no more room to expand. Frequently, staff offices double as ministry rooms. For many years we have desired a place where we could adequately take care of all the people who come to receive prayer for healing or who want to be trained in in-depth healing prayer know more about in-depth healing prayer.

But the need goes beyond just having a larger space; we believe an international,

interdenominational center is necessary. This new center will be a *visible sign* which proclaims that Christians believe that God still miraculously heals the sick.

What we hope to create is a holy place, a sanctuary, where everyone who is suffering can come and pray to receive God's healing power. We trust that it will is also be a destination where people will experience a special sense of God's love and experience healing just by being in God's presence.

What we know, beyond a doubt, is that many wonderful healings already take place through prayer, even in our very ordinary surroundings.



stronger in their relationships with God, gained greater Biblical and self-understanding, and have stepped out in more confidence to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit in ministry.

As always, the blessing has been entirely mutual! On our end, it is incredibly rewarding to see their contagious passion and hunger for the Lord. Simply having their fresh perspective and fervor has brought a new wave of vitality, emphasizing again the reason this ministry exists! For me personally, it has confirmed God's calling to invest in the younger generation. Ever since leaving college four years ago where I had been involved with on-campus prayer ministry, my passion for young adult ministry has been mostly lying dormant within, as I quickly became the youngest person here. But having these students around has renewed this call from the Lord to pour into and come alongside the next generation. And this call is not just for me! All over Scripture God commands the current generation to "tell of his works" to the next. A wonderful professor and mentor of mine from college often proclaimed Psalm 71:18 as a life calling, saying, "Even when I am old and gray, do not forsake me, O God, 'til I declare your power to the next generation, your might to all who are to come."

Now you certainly don't have to be old or gray to proclaim God's power to the next generation; this is a call for all of us. And there certainly is a need! Many, if not all, young adults grapple with serious issues, such as brokenness of identity and relationships, wounds from the family of origin or from trauma. That's not to mention the myriad of cultural temptations and pressures that lead to addictions, disorders, and deep emotional pain. Also, young adults generally tend to be very open and in such a ripe and critical time of formation—discovering their identity and making crucial life decisions. What a perfect opportunity to reach into their lives and help them encounter Jesus!

So what does this look like? This doesn't mean that everyone is necessarily called to active young adult ministry. Each of us can play different roles depending on our gifting or situation. The most natural way to do this is of course to share this ministry with the young people in your lives, whether children, grandchildren, friends or church members. You can do this by walking alongside them in their spiritual journey, encouraging them to seek God, to receive healing themselves, and to grow in His gifts and ministry to others. Another very practical way

to support them is to help financially sponsor them to attend conferences or ministry opportunities, such as our School of Healing Prayer®. Also, if you do not have any young people in your life, I invite you to pray and ask the Lord to bring some. In different seasons of my life I have had a few significant mentors who have immeasurably influenced my development as a person and connection with Jesus. I say this to encourage you! You never know the impact you can have on another simply by modeling, loving and being available to listen and pray. Finally, if you have young people in your life who are not open at this point, do not underestimate the power of intercessory prayer! Keep it up and take heart that God is at work!

I invite you to join me in praying for the next generation, echoing Paul's prayer that "...the eyes of [their] hearts may be enlightened in order that [they] may know the **hope** to which He has called [them], the **riches** of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great **power** for us who believe!" Eph 1:18-19 NIV



A Healing Place

Recently I was asked to pull together information about Francis MacNutt's ministry over the years. As impressive as it was, it really paled in comparison to the great love he has for God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. He exudes their love. Among those he served and taught were the leaders of the Presbyterian Church in Scotland, Lutherans and Baptists in Germany, and Pentecostals in the United States. Near the end of 2008, the Catholic Church sent priests from around the world to one place to receive training in healing prayer. That place was Jacksonville, Florida and the teachers were Francis and Judith MacNutt. Although I am not a priest, it was the first year I ever experienced a Christian Healing Ministries conference. I

was there meeting with the Board of Directors concerning the position of Director of Development. After our time together they suggested that I poke my head into the conference. When you listen to people who come to Christian Healing Ministries for prayer or to an event, there seems to be the same commonality that I experienced that day. At the time, I merely recognized that as I stepped in, I felt an amazing peace come over me. I sat down and didn't want to leave. What do you call that? In a recent conversation with Eleni, my friend and a friend of the ministry, she said she could identify some of what makes CHM unique. Here are her words:

"I was reading a devotional and meditating on Bethany, the place that Jesus always retreated to after being besieged in Jerusalem. He loved to go to Bethany because it was a place where He could be himself, where his friends (people he loved—Mary, Martha and Lazarus) always welcomed him, had intimate fellowship with him, listened to Him and waited for Him to teach them (Mary at his feet), believed in Him, and worshipped him. I thought that because of all those factors, it was the place where God was able to raise the dead. As I meditated on these thoughts I heard the Holy Spirit say....that is CHM."

"How true is that? CHM is a place where Jesus can be himself, is always welcomed, is loved and worshipped, where there is great faith in Him, where the people wait on Him, listen for His voice, and obey. All these things together make it possible for God to raise the dead there... I thought this might be relevant to the concept of the new Healing Center..."

That is our great hope and understanding of what God wants to do. He has been indicating that CHM is to build a place for anyone to come and experience safety and God's healing love - a haven. Francis had a dream of a square of light where whenever anyone stepped in the square they were healed. That square symbolized the healing center. Now we also know what it will look like. We are beginning to go to communities around the country to show the full set of renderings and share the complete vision. I look forward to being with you and sharing this magnificent dream which is soon to become a reality.

What an exciting time this is for the staff, volunteers, donors, and friends of CHM! There is so much happening in ministry at CHM each day and the coming center is a part of the picture. In these difficult times, more than ever we see people needing a place to come and be refreshed, set free, and energized. More than ever, Christians are seeing God answer prayers and bring healing. Our alumni have such incredible

ministries, and we see more prayer ministries budding and growing in churches where a faithful few have been patiently and diligently sowing seeds. One of my favorite things about this ministry is that those I meet or speak with who are friends of CHM are such wonderful people. You can immediately tell they love the Lord. Let's celebrate Jesus for who He is today. Let's say to Him, "Lord, we want you to be free to be who You are, completely, in Your fullness. We adore You for who You are. We just want to be near You. Thank you for loving us right where we are, for who we are today." He doesn't judge us. He just loves us! What a gift. God bless you and may God's healing love flow through you today!

The Boy Who Came Back from Heaven






